The authors of any material submitted to Studia UBB Negotia are required to cite appropriately any exact reproductions (verbatim), paraphrases and/or ideas taken from other materials. Studia UBB Negotia used the last version of APA citation style.

Also, the authors of any submitted material **are asked** to complete, sign and send along with their submission the below **Plagiarism statement**.

Any submission that is not accompanied by the Plagiarism statement will be discarded.
